

A Portrait of the Town of Turner Valley on May 20, 2008

The population count for Turner Valley in 2006 was 1906.

There was a 6% increase in the 2008 population count.

A total of 2022 residents resided in Turner Valley on the day of May 20, 2008.

Residents were surveyed to complete a snapshot of the demographics of the town and the survey results were as follows:

Of the residences enumerated:

- 81 % were single detached dwellings
- 13 % were duplexes
- 2.5 % were mobile homes
- 1.4 % were suites in single detached dwellings
- 1.3 % were quadruplexes
- 0.4 % were row housing
- 0.2 % were collective dwellings
- 0.2 % were apartments

Of the addresses enumerated:

- 86.4 % were either owned or rented
- 6.4 % were empty lots or under construction
- 4.4 % were vacant
- 2.2 % were residents living in Turner Valley for under 6 months and therefore not counted in the census
- 0.6 % refused to answer the census questions

Of the residents counted:

- 51.3 % were male and 48.7 % were females
