A Few of the topics that will be discussed at the Open House are listed below:

Raw Water Reservoir - benefits, challenges in construction and the difficult process;

Oil and Gas - issues within the Town limits; plans to address concerns of living among the "first oil and gas discovery community" and remediation;

Amalgamation - its process and review resident's comments;

Historic T V Gas Plant - ongoing work at the site;

Downtown revitalization - the exciting main street plans for commercial expansion as well as architectural proposals;

New Developments - the positive impact on the town as well as preparation for the growth and demands on the social and physical needs for our residents;

Infrastructure - although Turner Valley has one of the best infrastructure services in the area, we need to be prepared to keep up with the changes. The Water Reservoir is a good example, once in use it will guarantee an uninterrupted supply of water unlike some municipalities (Tofino last year, Black Diamond year before etc.), Our streets are 98% paved, our water treatment plant, (aside from the Town of Okotoks), is one of the newest and most modern plants in the Region.
