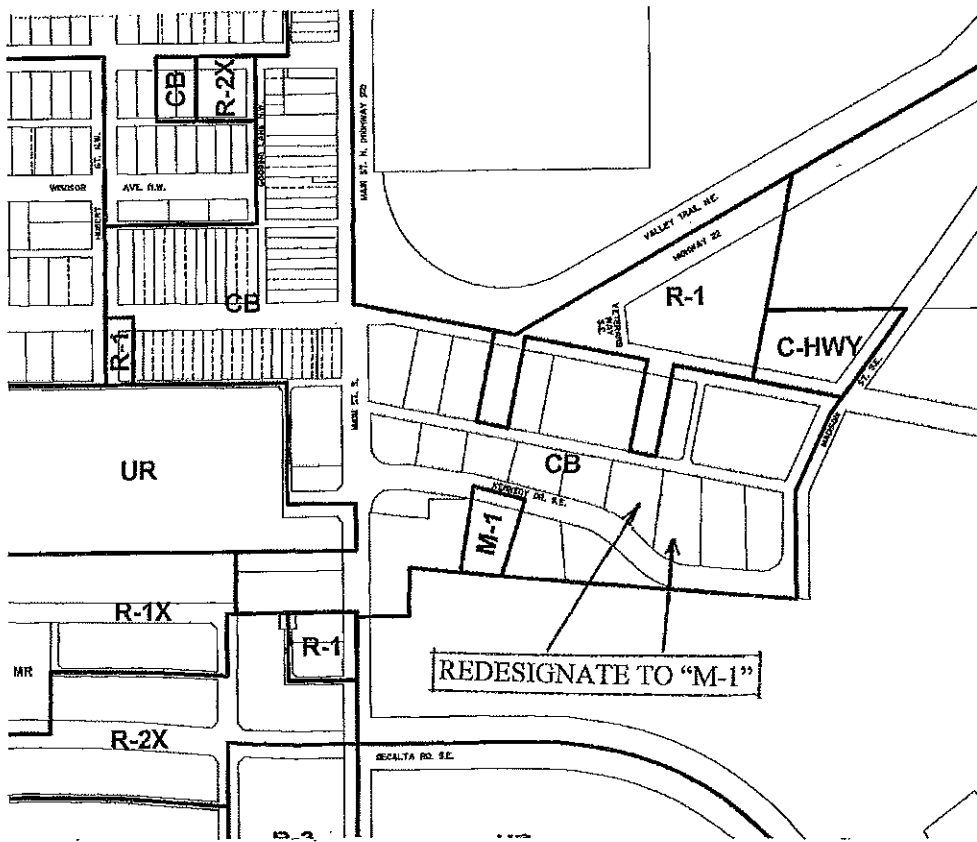
BEING A BYLAW TO AMEND THE LAND USE BY-LAW 03-869 OF THE TOWN OF TURNER VALLEY, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA.

WHEREAS Pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26.1, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, Council of the Town of Turner Valley in the Province of Alberta (hereinafter called the "Council") has adopted Land Use Bylaw 03-869; and

WHEREAS The Council deems it desirable to amend the Land Use Bylaw 03-869;

NOW THEREFORE The Council hereby enacts that Land Use Bylaw 03-869 be amended as follows:


1. Amending the Land Use Map of Land Use Bylaw 03-869 by re-designating lands described as Block 7, Plan 811 0166, municipally known as 206 Kennedy Drive, containing +/- .21 hectares (+/- .54 acres) Central Business District (CB) to Light Industrial District (M-1), as shown in the map below:
2. Amending the Land Use Map of Land Use Bylaw 03-869 by re-designating lands described as Block 8, Plan 811 0166, municipally known as 136 Kennedy Drive, containing +/- .19 hectares (+/- .49 acres) Central Business District (CB) to Light Industrial District (M-1), as shown in the map below:
