BYLAW 11-1015**


**BEING A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF TURNER VALLEY, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA,
TO AUTHORIZE AND REGULATE THE OPERATION OF ALLOWABLE OFF-HIGHWAY
VEHICLES "KNOWN AS GOLF CARTS" ALONG DIRECTED, CONTROLLED OR MANAGED
HIGHWAYS WITHIN THE TOWN OF TURNER VALLEY**

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Turner Valley does not have jurisdiction to authorize and regulate the operation of "Golf Carts" as they are not an approved off highway motor vehicle under the Alberta Traffic Safety Act RSA 2000, Chapter T-6.

THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Turner Valley in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled revokes Bylaw 96-733 prohibiting the use of golf carts on any and all roadways within the Town of Turner Valley.

THIS BYLAW comes into effect on the date of its **THIRD** and **FINAL READING**.


